Journal Description and Scope

Journal of Epilepsy Research is an official journal of the Korean Epilepsy Society and is published biannually (in March, September). Journal of Epilepsy Research publishes research articles in epilepsy and related fields including clinical and basic researches.

Types of Manuscript

Journal of Epilepsy Research publishes Reviews, Original Articles, Case Reports, and Editorials, and articles commissioned by the Editorial Committee. For Reviews, the authors must obtain permission from the Editorial Committee before submitting the manuscript. Case reports are considered for publication only when they are unique and illustrative. All manuscripts are subject to peer review.

References should be numbered serially in the text using numbers as unparenthesized superscripts: ^{3,7,10-12}. They should be listed on a separate sheet at the end of the paper in that order. Unpublished data and personal communications may be cited in the text (including the initials and surnames of all authors, and the year in which the observation was made), but should not be listed as references. Authors are responsible for the accuracy of references. Reference format should conform with that specified in "Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts Submitted to Biomedical Journals".
